ING'S GORGEOUS RIBBED POPPY

Colour A – red, **Colour B** - black

Abbreviations - UK/AUS: **Ch** – chain, **Sl st** - slip stitch, **St** – stitch, **Dc** - double crochet, **Tr** – treble, **Fptr** - front post treble (yarn over, hook from right to left of treble post, yarn over, pull thru 2 st, yarn over, pull thru remaining 2 st)

Colour B - 4 ch, 9 tr into first ch (4th from hook), sl st to join & fasten off.

Colour A - join at top of any tr st

R1: Dc + 1ch into same st (this is 1st tr)*Fptr into next st, 1 tr into top same tr*. Repeat from * to *, fptr into next st, sl st to top of 1ch, 1ch

R2: 1dc 1ch into same as sl st, 1 tr into next (fptr), *1 fptr into same tr post, 1 tr in next 2tr*, repeat from * to * fptr into next st, sl st to top of 1ch, 1ch

R3: 1dc 1ch into same as sl st, 1 tr into next 2 tr, *1 fptr into same tr post, 1 tr in next 3tr*, repeat from * to * fptr into next st, sl st to top of 1ch
Fasten off.

Decorate centre with small button, embroider or leave black as preferred.



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LYNN'S EASY CROCHET PATTERN

Col A - 1 ball red yarn (one ball will make a number of poppies)

Col B - Scrap of green yarn

Col C - Scrap of black yarn

BODY OF POPPY

Using Col A make a slip ring

1st round - Ch 3, 9 treble crochet into ring. Pull the slip ring tight to close centre of ring and slip stitch in top ch to join

2nd round - Ch 3, 1 treble crochet into first stitch 2 treble crochet into each stitch to last stitch, slip stitch in top ch to join

3rd round - Ch 3, 2 treble crochet into first stitch, 3 treble crochet into each stitch to last stitch, slip stitch in top ch to join

4th round - Ch 3, 1 treble into first stitch, 2 treble into each stitch to last stitch, slip stitch in top ch to join. Fasten off and sew in ends.

CENTRE OF POPPY

Using Col B Make slip ring. Ch 3, 9 treble crochet into ring. Pull end to close centre of ring and slip stitch in top ch to join. Fasten off and sew in ends.

Using Col C Join yarn into edge of circle on RS and Ch 1 * 1 double crochet into first stitch, 1 ch repeat from * to end of round and slip stitch to join. Fasten off leaving a long tail to attach centre to body of poppy.

FINISHING

Sew in ends for body of poppy. The ends for the centre can be sewn in if you wish or hide them behind when you sew on the centre. Using a yarn needle thread black tail and invisibly attach the centre to the body of the poppy.



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LORRAINE'S EASIER CROCHET PATTERN

Col A 1 ball red yarn

Col B Scrap of green yarn

Col C Scrap of black yarn

BODY OF POPPY

Using Col A make a slip ring

1st round - Ch 3, 9 treble crochet into ring. Pull the slip ring tight to close centre of ring and slip stitch in top ch to join

2nd round - 3ch, 4trtr in same stitch. In next stitch 5trtr, *in next stitch 1tr and 4trtr, in next stitch 5trtr.

REPEAT from * to end of round, ending with slip st in top to join. Fasten off. Sew in ends.

CENTRE OF POPPY

Using Col B - Make slip ring Ch 3, 9 treble crochet into ring and slip stitch in top ch to join. Pull tail end to close centre of ring. Fasten off leaving long tail to attach centre to body of poppy.

FINISHING

Using Col C - Cut 6 x 7cm lengths of yarn and using a small hook attach them like a fringe to the post of each stitch on Round 1. Stich centre to body of poppy.

NOTES

The petals are made up of 5 groups of 10 stitches worked over 2 trebles of the first round.



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MOLLY'S MEANDERINGS CROCHET POPPY

You Will Need:

green yarn

red yarn

black 'eyelash' yarn

crochet hook

Using green wool/yarn make 4 chain & join them with a slip stitch.

Row 1 - 2 chain, then 11 trebles into the ring. End green wool.

Row 2 - Join in red wool, work 2 chain & 1 treble, into the first space, work 2 trebles into each space.

Join with a slip stitch.

Row 3 - 2 ch & 1 treble into the first space,

1 treble into next space, 2 treble into the next*

Repeat from * to ** around the poppy.

Join with a slip stitch. Fasten off yarn.

Sew in all ends & trim neatly.

Work a row of backstitch in black eyelash yarn where the red & green rows meet. Use your darning needle to flip up the fluffy part of the eyelash yarn.



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LEDYS CROCHETED POPPY 1

Colour A – Green

Colour B – Black

Colour C – red

Either:

1.a. Colour A ch 3, sc to form loop.; 10 tr into loop,

or

1.b. magic circle and 10 tr then pull tight, sc to form circle

Leave a long tail

2. Colour B – ch 1, (dc, 2 dc) repeat to end, sc to end circle = 15 sts

3. Colour C – ch 2, 2 htr in ea st, sc to end circle = 30 sts

4. ch 1, 2 dc in ea st, sc to end circle = 60 sts

5. ch 2, (htr, htr, 2 htr) rep to end, sc.

Tie in ends



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ING'S HYBRID FRONT POST CROCHET POPPY

Black and red yarn

Using **BLACK** yarn, attach yarn to hook with a slip knot.

Make 4 chain and join with a sl st to form a circle

OR

work round 1 over a magic ring - whichever is your chosen method.

Round 1: 3 ch (counts as the first treble), 11 treble into the ring. Join with a sl st to the 3rd ch. 12 treble.

Fasten off black yarn.

Round 2: Using **RED** yarn join into the top of any treble from round 1. Chain 3 (first treble), into same space as ch 3 work 1 treble,

**work 2 trebles into each stitch* around and join with a sl st. 24 trebles.*

Round 3: Ch 2 (first half treble) **work 2 (or 3 if you want a more pronounced frill) front post trebles around the next stitch from round 2, work 1 half treble into the top of the same stitch and the next one** repeat around and join with a sl st.

Fasten off, darn in all ends, attach button if preferred and attach pin to back.
